PERSONAL STATEMENT

During my 28 years at the Department of Psychiatry at San Francisco General Hospital, I have participated in several phases of clinical, administrative, teaching and research activity.

From 1977 to 1980, I was primarily involved with initiating a University service of psychiatry at SFGH focusing on very basic changes in the inpatient program, medical records, and residency training, while at the same time providing direct clinical service.

From 1981-1988, I focused my efforts in originating and developing the Asian/Pacific American Psychiatric Inpatient Program. This Program was the first of its kind in the United States, and has served as a model for other programs such as the Asian/Pacific Inpatient Unit at Metropolitan State Hospital, which opened in October, 1986. It provides a unique service to the Asian/Pacific population of San Francisco. Our multi-cultural staff on site to provide services in Cantonese, Mandarin, Shanghainese, Tagalog, and Vietnamese and twelve other Asian languages and dialects of Chinese. Through arrangements with outpatient clinics, we have access to other Asian language staff. The Program liaisons actively with the other treatment modalities to provide a system of care for these patients. Where no modality existed, such as residential services for Asians, I have involved myself in the creation of such a program at Conrad House. I have worked actively in the Asian American Mental Health Task Force. The Asian/Pacific Focus Program on Unit 7C served as a model for the eventual development of five other ethnic/minority psychiatric inpatient programs at SFGH focusing on Latinos, Blacks, Women’s Issues, AIDS, and Lesbian/Gay/ Bisexual/ Transexual persons. I coordinated an application by these five programs for the American Psychiatric Association Achievement Award of 1987; we were awarded a Certificate of Significant Achievement.

Secondly, the Program has provided a unique training site for UCSF medical students, psychiatric residents, and other trainees who are interested in working with multicultural patients while being supervised by ethnic/minority faculty.

Minority medical students and residents have greatly appreciated the opportunity to train at the Program, and it has aided in the recruitment of minority psychiatric residents and elective medical students. I have contributed to the Department's effort to recruit and train minority medical students and residents. This clerkship facilitates recruitment of minority medical students to our residency program. During my 22 years on the Residency Selection Committee, I have been heavily involved in minority resident recruitment. In 1986, I became the Coordinator of this effort which succeeded in increasing the number of minority residents; currently, 30% of the residents are ethnic minority. Many residents I have supervised have been awarded APA/SAMHSA Minority Fellowships, and I encouraged many minority medical students and residents to participate in the Program for Minority Research Training in Psychiatry. In 1999, the American College of Psychiatrists awarded the Ethnic/Minority Psychiatric Programs the Creativity in Psychiatric Education Award. In 1999, 2000 and 2004, I was awarded the UCSF Psychiatric Resident's Association Excellence in Teaching Certificate (co-awardee).

On the national level, I had been active on the American Psychiatric Association Committee of Asian-American Psychiatrists, being the Chairperson from 1989 to 1992. During my years on the Committee, among other projects, we secured funding for the annual Asian/Asian-American Award (which was presented for the first time in May, 1992), co-sponsored an international symposium on psychiatric research in Asia with the Pacific Rim College of Psychiatrists (May 1989), and initiated a recruitment effort for Asian medical students to enter psychiatry. In the past 15 years, I have presented at the Annual Meetings of AADPRT, AAP and ADMSEP – three major organizations involved with psychiatric education – on the issue of minority resident recruitment and development and cultural competence. In 2005, I joined the Editorial Board of the journal Academic Psychiatry.

During my career, I have developed an area of expertise in transpersonal psychiatry and psychology. I am on the Board of Editors for the Journal of Transpersonal Psychology. I had presented workshops and have been a faculty member from 1989 to 2003 of a CME Course on Transpersonal Psychiatry at the APA Annual Meeting. With two colleagues, I proposed a new V Code category for DSM-IV entitled "Religious or Spiritual Problems," which was accepted by the Task Force on DSM-IV. I have also explored the interface of transpersonal psychology and film in my public seminars.

In 1995, as part of a SFGH Department of Psychiatry reorganization, I became Co-Director of the Cultural Competence and Diversity Program, a new program which will enlarge this work beyond the inpatient units to all divisions and disciplines within the Department. In 1997, I became a Director.

Since 1997, I have been immersed in development of Cultural Competence standards and performance measures with the Federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration Center for Mental Health Services (CMHS). In 1999, I was appointed to the National Advisory Council of CMHS for a three-year term. I also serve on the California State Department of Mental Health Cultural Competence Advisory Committee and the UCSF Chancellor's Committee on Diversity. In May 2001, I was awarded the American Psychiatric Association Kun-Po Soo Award that recognizes an individual who has made significant contributions toward understanding the impact of Asian cultural heritage in areas relevant to psychiatry. In May 2002, I was awarded a Special Presidential Commendation by the American Psychiatric Association for research, publications and advocacy for cross-cultural psychiatry.

More recently, I have very involved with diversity and equal opportunity activities at UCSF primarily through my service as Chairperson of the Academic Senate Equal Opportunity Committee and as the Chairperson of the Chancellor's Advisory Committee on Diversity, Faculty Search Committee. I served as Executive Scientific Advisor for the development of the videotape "The Culture of Emotions," which is a significant teaching tool on the DSM-IV Outline for Cultural Formulation. Since 2002, I chair the American Psychiatric Association Council on Minority Mental Health and Health Disparities.

In summary, I have devoted my career to date in the areas of public hospital psychiatry, cultural psychiatry, cultural competence and diversity, psychiatry and religion/spirituality, and residency training. I have experience in direct clinical care of minorities and the severely mentally ill; administration of clinical programs for minorities, women, and the severely mentally ill; and education of medical students and residents, especially focused on minorities.
